**Under this agreement for 2017
Meringandan State School will receive**

\$74,242

This funding will be used to

- Maintain the proportion of students above 35%, in Years 3 and 5, in the upper two bands in reading.
- Increase the proportion of students in the early years to above 75% achieving regional benchmarks in reading.
- Increase the proportion of students from 20% to above 30%, in Years 3 and 5, in the upper two bands in numeracy.

Our initiatives include

- Investing in capability development to implement high impact strategies to improve student outcomes in reading and numeracy.
- Implementing programs to build literacy, numeracy and oral language skills, including parent support.
- Engagement and transition programs that enhance partnerships with community groups, local playgroups, Crèche and Kindergarten, and day care providers.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Funding release to enable teachers to engage in professional learning and collaborative practices to build capability including observation, coaching and feedback, inquiry and action research. \$35 000
- Engaging a qualified professional to implement effective oral language programs and practices in the early years, including building teacher and aide capability. \$17 000
- Facilitating pre-Prep transition sessions and professional networks to ensure successful transitions. \$4 242
- Investing in resources, including digital resources and programs, to support teaching and learning in reading and numeracy. \$18 000
